LAST OF 2411

2017 saw the delivery of YN 61092, the last vessel in a series of 8 Tugs - ASD 2411 – delivered between Nov 2015 and Jan 2017. For our newbuilding team in Damen Shipyards Sharjah this represents a true journey of tug building excellence.

The 2411 Azimuth Stern Drive, is one of most efficient and top selling Damen tugs due to its unobstructed deck arrangements, powerful thrusters and modern interior.

The lead vessel was built for Sharjah Port, and the other vessels were delivered to international owners from Germany, the Netherlands and Italy.

Mr Anish Chittilappilly, Newbuilding Project Manager explains: “We started this project in 2014. After receiving the order we analysed the production of this series of tugs and set our targets. Today, when we have delivered the last and 8th ASD 2411 of its series, of which three have fire fighting arrangements, we are delighted and proud of what we have achieved. Some achievements over the last two years are:

- High level of detailed engineering to allow for full pre-outfitting from panel building stage. We pre-install piping and all supports for equipment and components.
- Superstructure is constructed and outfitted completely and separately by a single team, including exhaust pipes, painting, insulation etc. The complete superstructure is then joined with the vessel in one operation.
- Reduction in pre-commissioning and commissioning time
- Building time reduced from 13 to 11 months

The lessons learned from this series, have provided us with the right tools, knowhow and experience for applying this practice in our current and future projects.



LANDING CRAFT DUBAI STYLE

Albwardy Damen Jadaf has successfully completed the construction of High Speed Aluminium Landing Craft “Qaffay 3” for H H Rulers Office Dubai.

The brief for this landing craft was very specific and the vessel has been specifically designed for her owners. Completely designed and engineered in-house by Albwardy Damen engineering department, the outfitting is of a higher standard than normal commercial vessels and the vessel presents beautifully almost like a yacht. With a low draft and capable to carry one truck or two large 4*4 vehicles at a speed of 25 knots she is specifically designed to operate in the coastal and shallow waters of the United Arab Emirates. The design can also be adapted to include an enclosed wheelhouse or an accommodation if needed.

Qaffay 3 has main dimensions of 21.42mtr length overall, 5.1mtrs breadth and 1.8mtrs depth with a total deck carrying capacity of 14 tons. The Vessel is powered by 4 x 350hp Yamaha four stroke outboard engines with a cruising range of 225 Nautical Miles. Design and Construction of the Vessel took 7 months and was completed on schedule.

During sea trials, the Vessel achieved a speed of 37 knots, proving the optimized hull lines with minimum resistance forces and high quality construction. The Vessel proved very stable at these high speeds much to the appreciation of the Captain and Owners’ Representatives. The Vessel was handed over to the Client on 23rd March 2017.

A big thank you to Engineering and Construction team for making this prestigious project a huge success.

Red Sea Marine Services is a Saudi based company established in Jeddah in 1987 which owns and operates 42 vessels. This includes 16 tankers, 26 anchor handlers, harbour tugs and crew boats.

Mr. Vaheed, the technical manager of Red Sea Marine explains: "We have a long-term business relationship with Albwardy Damen Fujairah for harbour and voyage repairs. When the new Albwardy Damen shipyards opened in Sharjah the relationship was strengthened further. Our bunker tanker vessel Al Barakah was the first of our vessels docked at Albwardy Damen Sharjah for a special survey. In fact, the vessel was on dock during the inauguration of the yard in 2014. The other vessels that followed were Al Safa, Al Israa and Al Miraj.

SL LABUAN AT ALBWARDY DAMEN SHARJAH

Smit Lamnalco vessel is at the Albwardy Damen Shipyard in Sharjah regular visitors. This time and not a stranger is the 60 meter offshore supply vessel SL Labuan which was placed in March on the dock blocks for a regular dry-docking with additional modifications works. The modification were executed in a time constraint period in congested areas.

Works included:

- conversion and treatment of ballast tanks to oil recovery tanks
- modifying pipelines and vents
- create pump-room
- install new generator and air compressors
- deck modifications
- modify crane pedestal and replacement of the deck-crane
- installation of a full diving spread
- relocation of winches
- fabrication and installation of recovery davit
- inclining test

Beside this the vessel was provided with a fresh coat of paint.

Iliay Atanasov, technical superintendent at Smit Lamnalco commented: "the services and interactions with the Yards operational team are impressive and are required to finish our projects within the scheduled time frames".

EMPLOYEE HEALTH SCREENING – WHY IT'S WORTH DOING

Employee Wellness check-ups (health screening) can be used to help identify potential risk factors for future poor health and areas to focus on in order to optimise wellbeing. BULBOUS BOW REPAIRS IN PORT KHALID

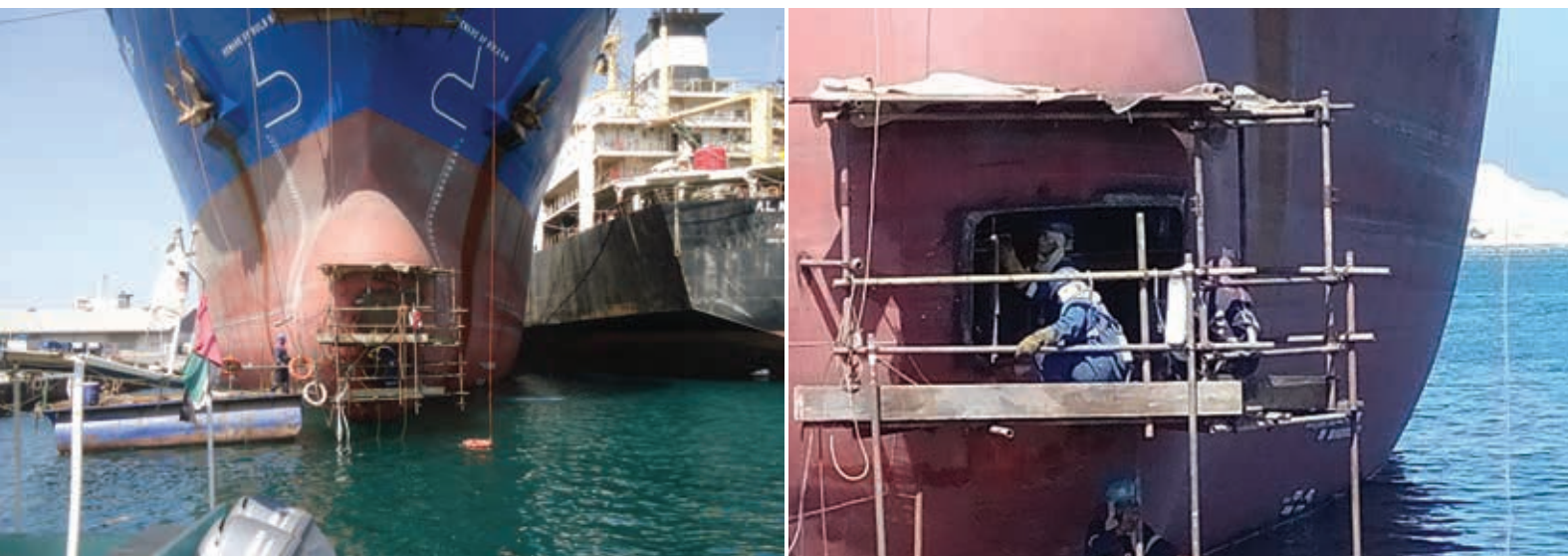
We attended a recent collision damage repair at Port Khalid Sharjah. MT Ares had arrived at Port Khalid with damaged bulbous bow and forepeak. Repairs in the bow area tend to be complex and challenging due to the shape and lack of easy access. The repair work was carried out in a very short timeframe and the vessel departed ahead of schedule.

Albwardy Damen has a lot of experience with these kinds of repairs. The bulbous bow and forepeak was restored, including

the damaged internal steel work performed by our skilled team in afloat condition with the help of hanging scaffolding and pontoon.

Importantly, this was identified as an issue as hand and fingers are more prone to injuries from our operations – use of hand and power tools, manual handling, equipment handling etc. and increase employees' understanding of their personal responsibility as part of a team, and the potential impact of accidents on the business as a whole.

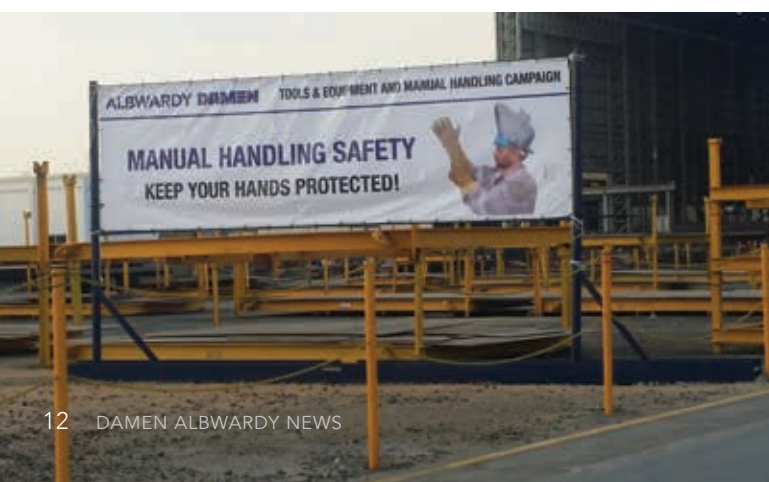
Key objectives for health and safety campaign are:

- Raise awareness of health and safety problems, including their causes and corrective actions amongst managers, supervisors and frontline employees.
- Increase workforce knowledge of relevant requirements and encourage compliance with this.
- Alert people to new risks and possible solutions.

Features of the campaign are:

- Display of banners and posters
- Short meetings with employees at site by the management personnel
- Toolbox talks by the supervisors and safety personnel
- HSE walkthroughs, inspections and management walkthroughs with specific emphasis on the topic etc.

A team comprising Management Team member, Project Managers, Coordinators, Supervisors and HSE staff spent time on site and talking to employees in small groups in all areas of the business.



DIVING & REPAIRS - FUJAIRAH

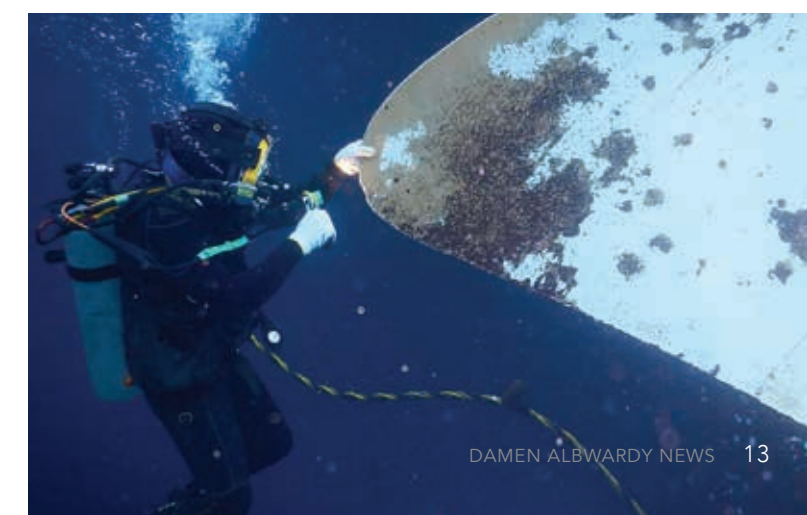
For our Fujairah team, 2017 started fantastic by achieving 5 years LTI Free, a true milestone for our operations. We carry out most of our jobs offshore in challenging conditions and safety is our always our no 1 priority.

The Albwardy Damen Fujairah office mainly serves afloat and diving customers in the region. Recently, in addition to our normal work on the Fujairah anchorage, we increasingly carry out work at the Mina Al Saqr anchorage.

The port has introduced a new safety induction, which is good, and shows the commitment to safety of all parties. The client's vessel was coming to Mina Al Saqr anchorage and Albwardy Damen Fujairah was contacted at very short notice to attend in the weekend. As all our teams were offshore, we had no immediate manpower available. However, we managed to release people from a team working on another mechanical job on the Khorfakkan anchorage. Thanks to our good cooperation with the authorities, our mechanics got CID clearance at short notice and attended to the vessel's.

Coming back to activities in Fujairah, sometimes we face positive challenges. Recently, we were requested to deliver on-board training on hydro blasting by a vessel operator who had purchased on-board hydro blasting equipment. It was really a proud moment to see our hydro blaster training the entire vessel crew (including Master and Chief Engineer) on the use of this equipment. He sailed onboard from Fujairah to Kuwait to conduct this training. A similar activity was conducted on a sister VLCC by the same hydro blaster.

Recently we did one hull cleaning job in association with our diving team. A client reported fouling both above and below the waterline. Our Diving department undertook the underwater cleaning and our Afloat team attended to the above water cleaning job. Having all equipment, including the service boat, in-house was a big benefit for the client, who was very happy with our performance and many times expressed that he will utilise our services in future.
