In 2025 we were busy almost throughout the year both in repair and newbuilding, with an all-time high newbuilding order book. We are still expanding our OEM Representations and Specialised Services. # Keel laying for Damen MPV 4916 *Smokey*

On 9th December 2025, we laid the keel for one of our major newbuild projects of 2026, the Damen Multi-Purpose Vessel (MPV) 4916 *Smokey* for Herman Senior B.V. This milestone marks an important step in the construction of this first-in-series MPV 4916 at Albwardy Damen through Damen Shipyards Hardinxveld.



Herman Senior is a long-standing client of Damen and frequently acts as the launching customer for first-in-series Damen designs, reflecting the shared values and long-term partnership between the two family-owned companies. During the Ceremony Mr Chris van Dodewaard and Mr Erwin van Dodewaard welded two Coins into the keel structure, symbolising good fortune, protection, and safe voyages for the vessel and her crew.

MPV 4916 *Smokey* is designed to perform a wide range of tasks within the offshore energy sector. The vessel will be equipped with DP2 dynamic positioning, a four-point mooring system, and spud poles, enabling station-keeping in diverse

environments and water depths. Additional features include a 45-tonne hydraulic A-frame and a crane fitted with an active heave compensated winch, allowing safe and precise lifting operations in challenging conditions.

The vessel is also prepared for a safe and sustainable future. *Smokey* will feature the Damen Marine NO<sub>x</sub> Reduction System (SCR), reducing emissions and noise while ensuring compliance with IMO Tier III requirements. The design is future-ready, with provisions for conversion to full electric or hybrid methanol propulsion.

Safety and comfort are key priorities, with the vessel designed in accordance with SPS Code, MLC 2006, and COMF-3 notation, accommodating up to 34 persons on board.

This keel-laying milestone reflects the dedication and teamwork of all involved in the project – Engineering, Procurement, Production, and Project support – and marks a strong start for this important project. We look forward to the continued progress of MPV 4916 *Smokey* and to delivering a vessel that is truly fit for the future. <<




# Albwardy Damen Sharjah hosts Lloyd's Register HSE visit

Albwardy Damen Sharjah recently welcomed a delegation from Lloyd's Register (LR) as part of a Group Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) visit.

The LR delegation included Philip Sayer (Group QHSE Director), Vitaliy Melnyk (Senior Surveyor in Charge), and Vishnu Vijayan (MEAI HSE Business Partner). The team was hosted by the yard's Operations Director, and Emil Akumah (Quality Manager), who provided a comprehensive overview of ongoing activities and safety practices across the facility.

During the visit, the delegation toured the yard from the shiplift and repair areas to the newbuilding aluminium welding sheds. Discussions focused on operational systems, safety controls, and the coordination of multiple vessels within a compact operational environment.

LR highlighted several strengths observed during the visit, including:

- ▶ Continued investment in infrastructure and systems
- ▶ The broad scope of repair and newbuilding activities
- ▶ Effective logistical management across concurrent projects
- ▶ Clear visibility of Risk Assessments in high-risk work areas
- ▶ Structured toolbox talk templates and attendance tracking

The Yard HSE Team was commended for its proactive approach, openness to feedback, and strong safety culture. The visit concluded with a reaffirmation of Lloyd's Register's commitment to ongoing collaboration and support. ◀◀

# 13 years LTI free and counting



Our Diving Department, consisting of 20 divers and two diving boats, is strategically located in Fujairah, continues to provide comprehensive underwater services across UAE waters and Salalah. The team has successfully executed several critical operations, including underwater repairs, underwater hull repairs, echo sounder renewal, and anchor recoveries.

A significant milestone is the achievement of more than 13 years of operation without a single Lost Time Injury (LTI), reflecting a strong safety culture and disciplined operational practices.

In addition, the department has completed numerous ship husbandry operations in full compliance with the latest New Zealand–Australia regulatory requirements.

For anchor recovery operations, we provide a complete one-stop solution, covering seabed scanning to locate lost anchors, safe recovery, and secure connection back to the vessel. Our in-house repair team supports all associated repairs, including anchor windlass gears and bitter-end mechanisms. Over the past few months, we have successfully retrieved and delivered anchors for multiple vessels.

Our core ship husbandry and underwater services—such as hull cleaning, propeller polishing, in-water surveys, underwater hull repairs, echo sounder renewals, and other specialized underwater interventions—have consistently demonstrated high levels of reliability and operational efficiency.

Other key underwater repair activities include repairs to overboard lines and valves for various systems, including scrubbers. Beyond marine operations, the team plays a crucial role in the periodic maintenance of major industrial facilities, including power plants. Notably, we have secured a long-term service contract with the new F3 Power Plant. <<

# Safeguarding life at height

Falls from height serve as a powerful reminder of the fragility of human life and the profound responsibility inherent in every action. Across workplaces worldwide, they remain a leading cause of serious harm, teaching us that vigilance, foresight, and care are essential virtues. Timeless guidance emphasizes that thoughtful planning, competent supervision, and the mindful use of protective measures are not just rules, but expressions of respect for life. These principles form the cornerstone of our company’s commitment to protecting those who work at height.

At Albwardy Damen, work at height has been recognized as an area demanding intentional focus in 2025. Employees are called to act with awareness, responsibility, and care in every task. Work at height encompasses any activity performed above ground or where a fall could occur, including platforms/scaffolds, ladders, manholes, and hatch openings without protection. Even brief or routine tasks can carry profound risk if hazards are overlooked or ignored.

Many fall incidents arise from unprotected edges, missing or inadequate guardrails, unsafe ladders or scaffolds, slippery or uneven surfaces, poor housekeeping, or improper use of personal protective systems. Often, these reflect complacency, lapses in planning, incomplete risk assessment, insufficient training, or weak

supervision. Such realities illustrate that most falls are foreseeable and preventable when hazards are truly recognized and addressed before work begins.

As part of the 2026 HSE Plan, company management will launch a campaign under the theme “Prevent falls, work safely at height.” This initiative seeks to awaken awareness, reinforce intentional planning, promote the use of approved access systems and collective protection, and ensure proper selection and application of personal protective equipment. Through constant mindfulness, shared responsibility, and disciplined practice, we aspire to remove fall hazards and honor the lives of everyone working at height. <<





With all required documentation in place, multiple services were efficiently carried out during voyages between Antwerp–Le Havre and Paris.

A major milestone was the successful overhauling of multiple Yanmar engines in Abidjan, Ivory Coast, where a specialized team mobilized from the UAE completed the project within the committed timeframe. To support increasing demand, additional engineers completed maker-approved Yanmar training, further expanding our pool of certified engineers and strengthening our ability to execute multiple projects in parallel.



# Successful completion of HIMSEN engine overhauls on LPG tanker

**Albwardy Damen Fujairah team completes overhauling of all three HIMSEN engines onboard an LPG carrier from a Europe-based customer at Khorfakkan Port.**


The project involved the comprehensive overhaul of three HIMSEN auxiliary engines (Model 6H21/32), executed in full compliance with approved standards and industry best practices to ensure reliable, efficient, and long-term operation.

Key services included the complete overhaul of cylinder heads, pistons, and connecting rods; honing of cylinder liners; servicing of fuel pumps, fuel injectors, and governors; inspection and renewal of journal and connecting rod bearings; cleaning and servicing of air coolers; overhauling of all attached pumps; inspection and servicing of turbochargers;

crankshaft deflection measurements; and final engine timing adjustments.

The work was carried out by our experienced engine service engineers, working closely with the vessel's superintendent and crew to address technical requirements and resolve any issues identified during servicing.

Following completion, all three auxiliary engines were successfully tested, with performance results demonstrating significant improvements across all units. The project was completed safely, on schedule, and to the required quality standards, reflecting our team's technical expertise and commitment to delivering reliable marine engineering solutions. <<
