On January 12, representatives of the Ukrainian Maritime Cluster (UMC) including MDEM as its member, met with a delegation of the French Maritime Industry Association (GICAN). The meeting has become possible due to support of the Ministry of Strategic Industries of Ukraine.

The aim of the visit was to explore prospective areas of collaboration between Ukrainian manufacturers and French companies participating in GICAN. The event took place at the Ukrainian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (Kyiv).

Representatives of the maritime shipbuilding industry of Ukraine took part in the meeting: Marine Design Engineering Mykolayiv LLC, C-Job Nikolayev LLC, Ocean Shipyard LLC, NIBULON LLC.
