

So if you want to have a look at one these type of vessels please let us know. This is very positive news and we are proud to consolidate our position as a major UAE ship builder.

In this magazine you will see our local new building customer NMDC featured, NMDC has taken delivery of a number of new buildings from our yard in Hamriyah. You will also see one of our repair customer/partner Trans Atlas Marine Services.

We have for the last few years also had an ongoing cooperation Sharjah Maritime Academy. We are very pleased to give the students a taste of both ship repair and new buildings. I think we are all looking forward to welcome the students to the shipping world.

From November until January we have been running our annual sport games. A BIG CONGRATULATIONS to all the winners and we hope and expect to see you all back at the games in 2025. ALBWARDY DAMEN NEWBUILDING Largest ever orderbook and 20 vessels under construction



With 20 Damen vessels currently under construction, including ASD tugs, Shoalbusters, and Multicats, our team is committed to delivering workhorses that stand the test of time.

Among our exciting projects is a one-off, special vessel for a long-term client – *Smokey*, a Damen Multi-Purpose Vessel 4916. This advanced vessel will feature dynamic positioning (DP2 system) and a diesel-electric propulsion system, set for completion in 2027. It's a prime example of our ability to design and build custom solutions for our clients' specific needs.

Our Newbuilding Department is driven by a team of over 600 passionate shipbuilders, whose expertise and dedication have contributed to the delivery of 170 newbuildings since the 1980s. From our Sharjah yard alone, we've delivered 110 units, with 14 vessels completed in 2024.

Currently, we have 41 vessels on order and 20 vessels actively under construction, showcasing our capacity and commitment to meeting the growing demands of the marine sector. Windlass repairs: quick

solutions for critical failures We recently assisted a vessel dealing with a windlass gear failure that prevented it from retrieving its anchor. Our team quickly came up with a temporary lifting solution and safely dismantled, reconditioned, and reinstalled the windlass assembly. This efficient repair ensured the vessel could depart on schedule with minimal downtime.


Line management involvement in employee safety engagement

Line management involvement in safety ensures accountability and ownership, integrating safety into daily operations and decision-making. This proactive approach fosters a stronger safety culture and enhances employee engagement, reducing reliance solely on safety officers.

Behavior Based Safety (BBS) – an effective tool Behavioral interventions, such as positive reinforcement and correcting unsafe behaviors, are highly effective in achieving line management involvement in safety. Positive reinforcement encourages desired behaviors by recognizing and rewarding safe practices, fostering a proactive safety mindset. Simultaneously, addressing unsafe behaviors through coaching and guidance helps build awareness and accountability, enabling line management to lead by example and drive a sustainable safety culture.

BBS interventions at Albwardy Damen


At Albwardy Damen, line management's involvement in safety has been greatly strengthened through the implementation of behavioral interventions. Since 2015, we have introduced Behavior-Based Safety (BBS) initiatives aimed at line staff, leading to significant improvements in employee engagement and accountability. In 2024 alone, these efforts resulted in 9,516 BBS interventions, demonstrating a strong commitment to a proactive safety culture. These efforts have driven a remarkable transformation in the organization's safety principles, fostering a proactive approach to risk management. This shift is evidenced by





a consistent reduction in the Total Recordable Injury Rate (TRI'f), highlighting the effectiveness of our interventions in achieving safer workplaces.

As of January 1, 2025, we have implemented an online platform for Behavior-Based Safety (BBS) reporting, replacing paper-based observation cards and drop boxes. This new system enhances efficiency in reporting, database management and analysis, ensuring better time utilization and contributing to the company's sustainability initiatives. **«**

In addition to large-scale propeller repairs, our team also provides reconditioning, pitch correction, and dynamic balancing services for smaller propellers, serving local clients in Fujairah and Dubai. 
The 22-man team was led by Professor Hongseok Bae.

The Damen Multicat's are designed for versatility and efficiency at deep and extremely shallow waters. This vessel is an absolute workhorse fully equipped for multipurpose works from dredging support to offshore construction works.

Furthermore, Albwardy Damen is speculative constructing an additional Multicat 2712 and Multicat 3313 for delivery end 2025, to fulfill the regional and global growing market demands for shallow draft workboats. **«**
