

The shipyard has a rich history and is proud to retain the Verolme name. Mr. Cornelis Verolme started building the large drydock in Rotterdam's Botlek area in 1970.

This 405×90 m graven drydock can easily accommodate rigs, such as semi-submersibles and jack-ups as well as the largest vessels in the world. The two other graven docks also aim to cater for the larger vessels sailing our globe.



Damen Shiprepair & Conversion (DSC) has a worldwide network of sixteen repair and conversion yards of which thirteen are located in North West Europe.

Facilities at the yards include more than 50 floating and (covered) drydocks, the largest of which are 420x80 and 405x90 metres, as well as slopes, ship lifts and indoor halls. Projects range from the smallest simple repairs through Class' maintenance to complex refits and the complete conversion of large offshore structures.

DSC completes around 1500 repair and maintenance jobs annually, both at yards as well as in ports and during voyage.
